- -Ensure proper supervision and conduct by all assistant and volunteer coaches

#### Pre-Season

- Attend CAA Coaches Meeting
- Establish a plan and guidelines for tryouts and practices
- Monitor completion of student-athlete sports packet and physical before tryouts.

- Plan and execute pre-season meetings to communicate dates and times of practice and games, as well as Student-Athlete and Parent responsibilities.
- Monitor completion of student-atheltes required NFHS and Barrows Conclusion Courses and Athletic Fee.

#### Season

- Coaches must articulate behavior expectations at the beginning of the season, and the consequences for failing to meet these expectations (WSST Rules and Policies Must Be Followed)
- Supervised students before, during, and after practice/games. This includes home and away games and during travel.
- Participate in all Sports Fundraisers and Car Washes (Plan and execute team fundraiser)
- Enforfed the Academic Policy.
- Game setup and takedown for home games. Includes required scorebook and scoreboard.
- Provided necessary roster information to the Athletic Department
- Provide student-athletes with necessary equipment.
- Provide Atheltic Department Game Scores and Stats.

#### End of Season

- Ensure accurate inventory, storage, issuance, care, and collection of all school athletic equipment.
- Participate in nominating and voting for CAA Region and All-State players.
- o Pan and execute the end-of-the-season banquet celebration
- Provide the Athletic Department with the necessary information for end of the year banquet/celebration.
