Position Summary:

The ITM & EL Support Teacher serves a dual role by designing and managing asynchronous instructional content for I Days under the Instructional Time Model (ITM), while also acting as the school's permanent building substitute with a focus on supporting the academic and linguistic needs of English Learners (ELs). This unique role ensures students have access to high-quality, equitable instruction both during non-traditional instructional days and in daily in-person support, especially for multilingual learners. The position plays a critical part in ensuring instructional continuity, compliance with state law (A.R.S. § 15-901.08), and language support services across campus.

Primary Responsibilities:

Instructional Time Model Responsibilities:

- Design and publish asynchronous learning modules aligned to district pacing guides and content standards for use during I Days.
- Create engaging, student-centered content that integrates multimedia, checks for understanding, and culturally responsive practices.
- Coordinate with the DCIA and grade-level/content teams to ensure lessons align with in-person instruction.
- Upload content and monitor student engagement through the district's learning platform.
- Maintain instructional documentation for audit purposes and instructional time compliance.

Permanent Building Substitute Responsibilities:

- Serve as the designated daily substitute teacher across all grades and content areas, filling in for staff absences as needed.
- Maintain instructional continuity by following teacher lesson plans and supporting classroom management.
- Build strong relationships with students and staff to support a positive school culture and ensure smooth transitions during staff absences.

English Learner (EL) Support Responsibilities:

 Provide instructional support for EL students during substitute assignments and designated intervention times.

- Assist the Program Manager of EL in delivering push-in or small group instruction, language acquisition activities, and progress monitoring.
- Help gather documentation and student work samples to support compliance with EL programming requirements (e.g., AZELLA progress, ELP standards).
- Collaborate with general education teachers to ensure EL students' access to core content and accommodations.

Required Qualifications:

- Valid Arizona Substitute Teaching Certificate (or equivalent if in charter setting).
- Demonstrated experience working with English Learners or in multilingual classrooms.
- Proficiency in instructional technology platforms used for asynchronous learning (e.g., Google Classroom, Canvas, Nearpod).
- Strong interpersonal, organizational, and communication skills.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience in curriculum development, digital learning environments, or EL instructional support.
- Familiarity with ADE ITM requirements, AZELLA data, and federal EL program compliance.
